



VISITING THE CGS LIBRARY

Learn about the protocols and procedures at the Library to ensure compliance with COVID-19 health guidelines and to help you have a safe visit.

When is the Library open?

- Our initial re-opening days are Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays
- You can register for an appointment from 10:00 am-12:30 pm and/or from 1:00 -3:30 pm
- The library is not open on Saturdays to be in compliance with requirements for air quality and circulation

How do I get into the Library?

- You MUST be registered to access the Breuner building and the CGS library; this is a security protocol now in place. Register for a visit on the www.californiaancestors.org website.
- The Breuner building is unlocked on weekdays. You will need to check in with the Security Desk in the lobby and then proceed to the Lower Level where our volunteers will admit you.

Can I bring friends or family with me?

- No, each individual must register separately

Do I need to wear a mask even if I am vaccinated?

- Yes, use of a mask is required in public areas of the Breuner Building and during the whole time of your CGS library visit. We will supply you with a mask if you forget.

Can I bring my lunch or snacks?

- No, eating and drinking in the library is not allowed
- There are nearby options for food and drink outside the Breuner Building and at the first floor cafe.

What else is different at the library?

- You will be asked to verify symptom questions upon checking in
- The library will have supplies of hand sanitizers, wipes, disposable gloves available for use.
- Visitors will wash or sanitize hands and wipe down keyboards and surfaces after use
- Gloves will be available to use the copier/printer control keys
- Access to the book aisles will be limited to one person at a time

What options are available for parking?

- Nearby paid parking structures are recommended for safety and are listed on our CGS website
- Parking meters nearby are limited to two hours; however for safety, garages are recommended
